**Designating McLaughlin Street & Pecan Street as
One-Way during Designated Hours**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF TIMPSON, TEXAS
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2011/8/16/2 DESIGNATING MCLAUGHLIN
STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET IN A WEST BOUND DIRECTION
FROM BEAR DRIVE TO HOLLY STREET DURING THE
DESIGNATED HOURS OF 3:00 PM TO 4:00 PM AND DESIGNATING
PECAN STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET IN A NORTH BOUND
DIRECTION FROM HWY 87 TO MCLAUGHLIN STREET DURING
THE DESIGNATED HOURS OF 7:00 AM TO 8:30 AM AND 3:00 PM
TO 4:30 PM.**

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Timpson, Texas:

SECTION 1.

That McLaughlin Street is hereby designated for one-way traffic only, in a west bound direction, from Bear Drive to Holly Street from the designated hours of 3:00pm to 4:00pm and that Pecan Street is hereby designated for one-way traffic only in a north bound direction from Hwy 87 to McLaughlin Street during the designated hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. The Public Works Department is hereby authorized and directed to cause the placement of appropriate signage.

SECTION 2. Penalty

Any person, firm, or corporation convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be fined an amount not less than \$1.00 or more than \$200.00, except that in the event state law provides for a greater penalty than that provided herein, such greater penalty shall apply. Each occurrence of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. Severability

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Timpson that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this code are severable; and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. Effective Date

That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, publication as required by law and upon completion of the necessary sign placement.
