REGISTRATION

- 1. All teams must be registered by Noon October 17th- Team captains must send entry form in to Denise.Mathews@gibsons.com
- 2. Team Captains must have the team waiver forms completed and signed by each team member prior to check in.
- 3. All participants must check in 15 minutes before their scheduled heat
- 4. There is \$10/person Registration Fee; pledge donations are encouraged
- 5. Jr. ATV will have \$5 / person Registration Fee (parental waiver approval required)

GIBSON will match all money raised.

RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1. Late or No Show teams will be disqualified
- 2. Each team must have a minimum of 8 and maximum of 10 players
- 3. If a team has an ineligible team member on the rope at any time, the team will forfeit and default from the event
- 4. Gloves will be provided for personal protection in order to prevent rope burns or injury
- 5. Team members are not allowed to wrap the rope around their arms or bodies
- 6. Pulls are timed from the starting horn and stopped once the front tires of the truck cross the end line
- 7. The top 3 teams with the best times will move on to the final pull.
- 8. The final 3 teams will pull once more as a single timed pull to determine the champs
- 9. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and will result in the removal of an offending player. This may include (but is not limited to):
 - a. Unnecessarily rough tactics
 - b. Harassing or threatening an official, volunteer or staff member
 - c. Derogatory statements or abusive language
- 10. We encourage you to represent your team with team t-shirts and to bring out supporters and fans to cheer on all the teams.

HEALTH AND SAFETY TIPS

- 1. Protective equipment requirements:
 - Leather work gloves (provided to protect from rope burns and blisters)
 - Long pants and long sleeved shirts (to protect from road rash in the event of a slip or fall to the road surface); jeans would work well (but not required)
 - Preferably runners (t-shoes), but fully enclosed footwear with rubber grip soles will do, with heavy socks (to provide good traction and to protect against blisters)
 - Advise wearing sun glasses and sun screen in the event of high UV index
- 2. Keep well hydrated and be prepared for all weather.
- 3. A qualified volunteer driver will be provided in the vehicle at all times
- 4. Event Cancellation; the event will take place rain or shine. In the event of severe weather, where safety is an issue, Gibson Management will have the final decision regarding event delays or cancellations.

This activity is voluntary, it is physically demanding.

All participants must ensure they are capable of performing the activity safely.
