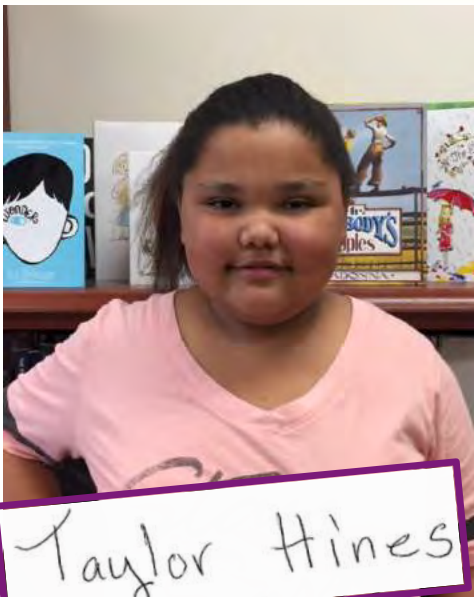




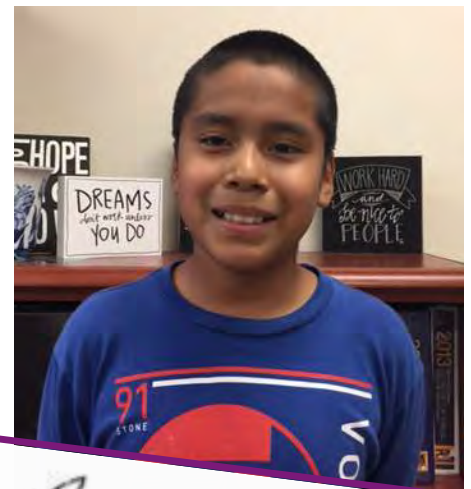
Riders of the Week
