



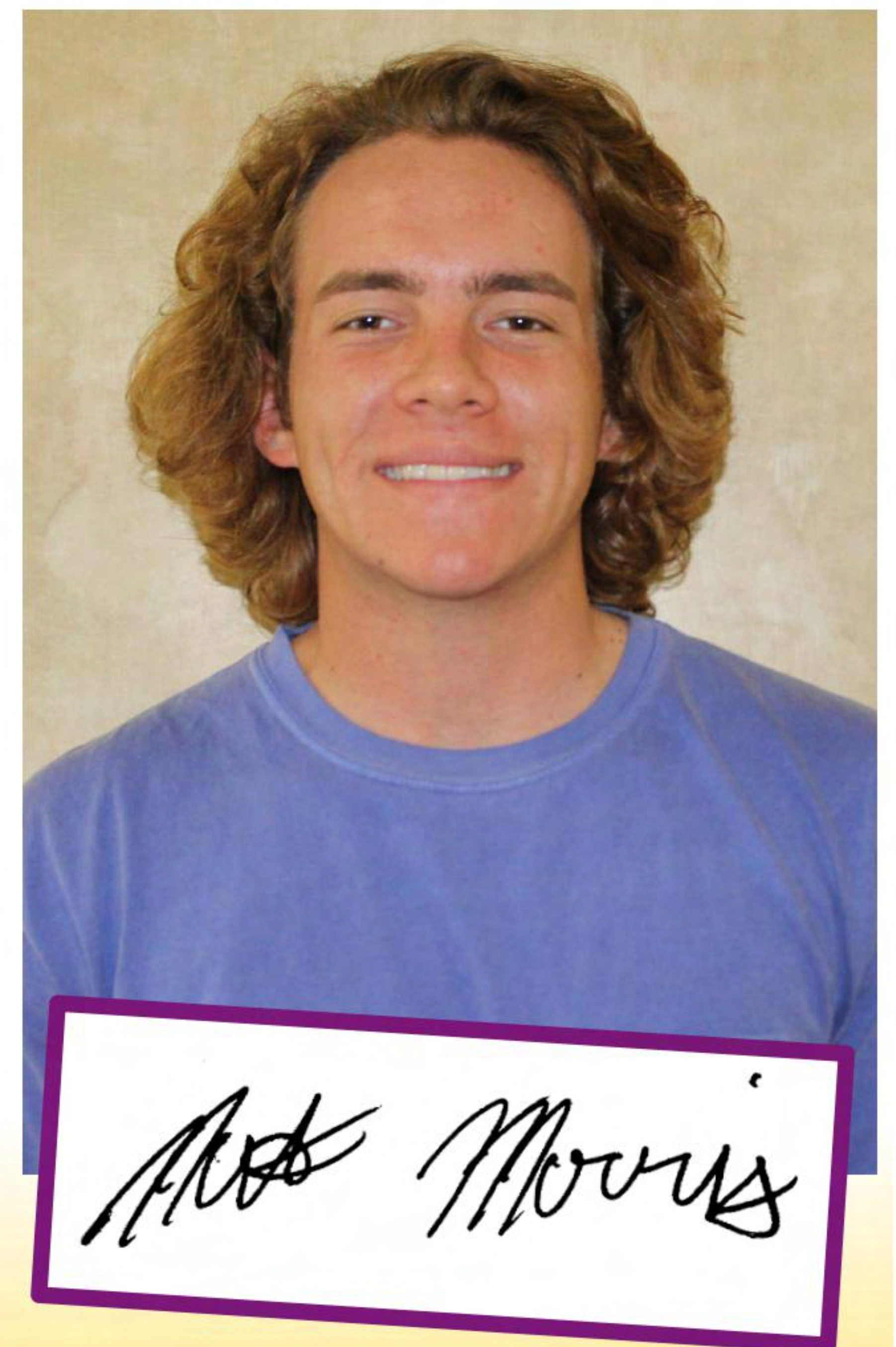
Riders of the Week
