At the October Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees hosted at Center High School, plans for the new Event Center were unveiled, as well as a video fly through rendering of the facility. CHS is off to a great start in 2019/2020. This school year ushers in a new era in campus guidance with the first Student Congress elected, under the guidance and sponsorship of Miss Burleson. The Student Congress meets weekly during Flex Lunch, and has recently concluded their first meeting with Mr.Gregory. The Student Congress is currently in the process of planning events and making student body recommendations to the CHS leadership.

During September 3rd through 5th, all seniors were given the opportunity to take the ASVAB. Military recruiters were on site to administer the test, and have since begun meeting with prospective recruits on the benefits of military service.

All students in the 9th and 10th grades, as well as all students needing to retake the Eng 1 or 2 EOC have been MAP screened. Plans based on the results have been developed for each student who is struggling with reading.

On October 1st Center High School Seniors were offered a free ACT administration thanks to funds made available in House Bill 3.

At the October Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held at Center High School, many students who met their progress measure on either the English 2 EOC or Algebra 1 EOC were recognized.

Center FFA boasted the Grand Champion, and Reserve Grand Champion Broilers at the county wide 2019 Poultry Festival Broiler Show.

The Roughrider Marching Band has again received a 1st division rating at the UIL Marching Competition.

As the Cross Country and Tennis Seasons come to a close, CHS will again be well represented at regional competition. Volleyball and Football are in the middle of their district schedule and postseason dreams are alive and well! Look for bi-district information in early November. CHS continues to promote and push literacy instruction across the curriculum. All students who have made two or more attempts on the English 1 or English 2 End of Course Test without being successful are receiving support for reading and writing specialists every day. In Addition, students in English 1 or English 2 who are not on track to be on grade level by the end of the school year are receiving remediation weekly.

The new student parking lot construction is underway and making significant progress. Expect concrete to be poured soon!

The HVAC Retrofit of the 300 and 200 wings is nearing completion, with all classrooms and the hallway completely up and running. Construction is underway for the replacement of the climate control in the CHS Gym.
